7:30-8:30am	Morning Hana li`ili`i: Groups harvest produce & supplies for food prep <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Huki &amp; wash/stack kalo</li><li>• greens/salad harvest</li><li>• Prep Laulau stuff (gather/wash la`i, lu`au, cut/salt meatprep tools for hana</li><li>• Begin making lei &amp; wrapping makana for Friday presenters</li><li>• Get ready for breakfast, and food prep for other meals</li></ul>
8:30-11:30am	Hana Nui Project: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Prepare: Use bathroom, get tools, gloves, plants, put on tabi, meet in big tent for explanation of project goals, guidelines &amp; instructions on tool use, split into 2 groups.</li><li>• Walk over to lo`i side in groups</li><li>• Grp 1: Clean lower auwai/Grp 2 Plant Koa, weed/water</li><li>• Change sites</li><li>• Grp 1 Clean upper auwai/Grp 2 Plant Koa, weed/water</li><li>• Check out manowai &amp; stream</li><li>• Walk down auwai &amp; back to hale</li></ul>
